WHAT IS AN STI?

PREVIOUSLY CALLED STD

An infection caused by an organism (bacteria, virus, or parasite) that can be passed from one person to another during sex or intimate contact.

ANYONE CAN GET AN STI

Whatever your age, gender, ethnicity or sexual orientation, if you are engaging in any sexual activity, you can get an STI
